2. Personal data and their use

We require your personal data in the following cases:

Business and order processing

We store personal data primarily for business and order processing. For this purpose we also pass on personal data to third parties who act for or on behalf of corbit GmbH (§11 BDSG, so-called order data management). These are, for example, courier services that deliver your ordered goods to you. These companies are not authorized to use the information we share with them for any purpose other than that about which we inform you in this statement.

Contact form

If you send us enquiries using the contact form, your details from the enquiry form, including the contact data you provided there, will be stored for the purpose of processing the enquiry and in the event of follow-up questions. We will not pass on this data without your consent.

newsletter data

If you would like to subscribe to the newsletter offered on the website, we require an e-mail address from you as well as information that allows us to verify that you are the owner of the e-mail address provided and that you agree to receive the newsletter. Further data will not be collected. We use these data exclusively for the dispatch of the requested information and do not pass them on to third parties.

You can revoke your consent to the storage of the data, the e-mail address and its use for sending the newsletter at any time, for example via the "unsubscribe" link in the newsletter.

3. Legal basis of data processing

- a. For the fulfilment of contractual obligations (Article 6 para. 1b DSGVO)
- b. On the basis of your consent (Article 6 para. 1 a DSGVO), for example to receive the newsletter.

4. Data security

Protection of our Internet presence and IT systems We protect our website and our other IT systems against the loss of availability, integrity and confidentiality through appropriate technical and organisational measures.

SSL encryption

This site uses SSL encryption for security reasons and to protect the transmission of sensitive content, such as the requests you send to us as the site operator. You can recognize an encrypted connection by the fact that the address line of the browser changes from "http: //" to "https: //" and by the lock symbol in your browser line. If SSL encryption is enabled, the data you submit to us cannot be read by third parties.

Storage of personal data

We only store personal data for as long as it is necessary for the purposes for which it was collected or to meet legal requirements for reporting or document retention. • Fulfilment of retention periods under German commercial and tax law: These include German Commercial Code and the German Tax Code. The periods for storage and documentation specified there range from two to ten years.

We commit ourselves neither to make any copies or other records of the personal data transferred or made available for processing nor to tolerate that third parties duplicate these data nor to pass them on to third parties. This does not apply to copies or other records that are absolutely necessary in the course of proper data processing.

We only use employees and subcontractors who are committed to data secrecy.

We protect all data effectively against unauthorized access, modification, destruction or loss, unauthorized transmission, other unauthorized processing and other misuse, as far as this is possible with technically and economically justifiable expenditure.

5. Data access

Within corbit GmbH, those departments get access to your data which need them to fulfil our contractual and legal obligations. Service providers and other support functions used by us may also receive data for these purposes if they comply with our written instructions according data protection law. We may only pass on information about you if you have given your consent and/or if our service providers guarantee to work according to European General Data Protection Regulation. (DSGVO/BDSG).

6. Right to information, deletion, blocking

You have the right to **free information** according Article 15 DSGVO, the right to **correction** according Article 16 DSGVO, the right to **deletion** according Article 17 DSGVO, the right to **limitation** of processing according Article 18 DSGVI, the right of **contradiction** according Article 21 DSGVO and the right to **transfer** data according Article 20 DSGVO. The restrictions according to §§ 34 and 35 BDSG apply to the right to information and the right of cancellation.

In addition, you have the right to complain to the data protection supervisory authority (Article 77 DSGVO in conjunction with § 19 BDSG).

This does not apply to data whose correction, blocking or deletion is contrary to legal or contractual retention periods.

You can revoke your consent to the processing of personal data at any time. Please note that the revocation will only take effect in the future. Processing that took place before the revocation is not affected by this.
